Tom's Testimony

I was raised in a godly home and accepted Christ during a 10th grade English class. Shortly after, I was baptized at Trinity Baptist Church. God has used visiting missionaries, mission's trips, the illness and death of my late husband and His Word to call me into missions. He has given me an abundance of opportunities and an overwhelming desire to share Christ with those around me.



Our Calling

In 2014, we began to pray more earnestly about where God specifically wanted to use us. During this time, God gave us a burden and desire to serve in Tanzania. We continued to pray and seek godly counsel. After reaching out to the Schultz family in Moshi, we learned that they had been praying for God to send help. In April of 2016, Kelli and I flew to Tanzania for 2 weeks to see the area and confirm God's calling. Over those two weeks, God moved our hearts to Tanzania. We are eager to share this burden while serving God on deputation.
